



PRELIMINARY SITE EVALUATION CRITERIA For a Public Shooting Range in Jefferson County

Basic Evaluation Criteria, subject to some level of flexibility & Site Conditions	
Distance from residential & non-residential development	Minimum ½ mile (or 2,640 linear feet)
Distance from recreational development (trails, campgrounds, recreation areas)	Minimum ¼ mile (or 1,320 linear feet)
Distance from communication towers	Minimum ¼ mile (or 1,320 linear feet)
Slope	20% or less
Site Access	Adjacent to County or State maintained road
Drive Time to Facility	30 Minute Drive Time Maximum from Intersection of C-470 & I-70
