Purpose: To assure reasonable access to the Jefferson County Hall of Justice

Policy: Parking Regulations

A. Intent

This parking control regulation is established pursuant to the authority contained in Section 18-9-117, C.R.S. 1973, in order to assure reasonable access to the Jefferson County Hall of Justice for all First Judicial District and Jefferson County Court judges; the District Attorney of the First Judicial District; and for designated key personnel of the District and County Courts of Jefferson County and the District Attorney's Office.

B. Definitions: As used in this regulation, the following words shall have the following meaning.

1. Licensed towing carrier: means a towing carrier as defined in Section 40-13-101(3), C.R.S. 1973, who has been issued a permit pursuant to Section 40-13-102, C.R.S. 1973.
2. Parking areas: means those areas adjacent to the Hall of Justice, Jefferson County Courthouse and Jefferson County Jail commonly used for the parking of vehicles which are under the control and jurisdiction of Jefferson County.
3. Vehicle: means any device which is capable of moving itself or of being moved from place to place upon wheels.

C. Reserved Parking Spaces Established

1. From time to time the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County may by written resolution designate specific parking spaces to be reserved within the parking areas for First Judicial District and Jefferson County Court judges, the District Attorney of the First Judicial District, and for designated key personnel of the District and County Courts of Jefferson County and the District Attorney's office, and may issue vehicle identification stickers to said individuals, which shall be placed on the rear bumper of each vehicle to be parked within the designated reserved parking spaces.
2. Official signs shall be posted in front of each parking space designated by written resolution to be a reserved parking space. Such official signs shall be conspicuous and shall contain the following language which shall be printed on each side of the sign:

RESERVED PARKING
TOW AWAY ZONE

D. Parking Prohibited

1. It is unlawful for any person to park any vehicle which does not have a vehicle identification sticker within a designated reserved parking space which has been posted with an official sign. Any person violating this regulation is guilty of a class 3 misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable as provided by law.
2. Any vehicle which is parked in violation of this regulation may be removed from the parking space. Removal of such vehicles shall be done by a licensed towing carrier at the request of the County. Payment of all storage and towing charges of the licensed towing carrier shall be the responsibility of the owner or operator of the towed vehicle and shall be paid by the owner or operator directly to the towing carrier. The location of any vehicle towed pursuant to this regulation may be obtained from the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office, 200 Jefferson County Parkway, Golden, Colorado 80419, (303) 277-0211.

E. Severability

Should any sections, clause, sentence or part of this regulation be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect, impair or invalidate the regulation as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
