Monday, May 5, 2014

A. Call to Order

Meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m.

B. Approve Minutes

Meeting minutes were approved.

C. Present 2014-2015 Goal

1. The 2014-15 Juvenile Justice High-Risk Victims goal was reviewed. This goal will work in tandem with the established work of the CYLC Human Trafficking Subcommittee and its workgroups.
2. There was concern regarding losing momentum around the 1st Judicial District Young Juvenile Program (Youngers Program) if the group submitted a separate goal that addresses Human Trafficking. There was also concern that if the Youngers Program was not the incentivized goal submitted by the subcommittee, the subcommittee would not be able to access 1451 funds to support juveniles and their families involved in the program; however Amy Terry provided clarification stating that 1451 funds are not required to be tied to an incentive goal.
3. It was decided that the Juvenile Justice Subcommittee would continue to work on the Youngers Program as a non-incentivized goal, and submit the High-Risk Victims goal as the incentivized 1451 Juvenile Justice goal.

D. MOU Check-In

1. The most recent draft of the MOU was reviewed and distributed to members of the subcommittee.
2. A level system was established to identify risks and needs of each youth. Level I: Low-Risk; Level II: Medium Risk; and Level III: High Risk. Level II youth will be the focus of the Youngers Program.

3. The MOU will include mandated partners. Partners who participate in the Youngers Program as part of an individual youth's MAP will not be included in the MOU or obligated to sign it. (The terms Treatment Plan and Mutually Agreed upon Plan (the MAP) are used interchangeably.)
4. Several changes were discussed by the group and documented by Amy Terry in the MOU as reflected in 05-05-2014 draft.

ACTION ITEM: Changes were distributed electronically; subcommittee members will review the changes and submit them back to Ms. Terry by May 26, 2014.

E. CANS Check-In

1. Twenty-eight CANS have been collected as of today. In order to meet the incentivized goal, an additional twelve CANS need to be collected by May 30, 2014.
2. A timeline and summary was illustrated by Jeff McDonald in the fishbone model on the white board (see electronic photo attachment).

F. Adjourn

Meeting was adjourned at 4:45p.m.
