MAPPING PRODUCTS DESCRIPTION FOR THE SENIOR POPULATION AND POVERTY MAPS BY CENSUS TRACTS

- Pie Chart Map
A breakdown of population aged 60 years and older by Census Tract, in Jefferson County, Colorado. Census Tracts (Source - 2000 US Census)
 - Total population of people 60 and older as of April 1, 2000: 70,078
 - Yellow - % of total per census tract, age 60 - 74
 - Blue - % of over 60 population, age 75 - 84
 - Red - % of over 60 population, age 85 – above

TOTAL SENIOR POPULATION AND PERCENT OF SENIOR POPULATION BY CENSUS TRACT (2000 CENSUS)

- Light green to dark green map shows the percent of senior population by Census Tract
This map shows the percent of population 60 years and above by Census Tract (Based on 2000 Census data). The dark green Census Tracts indicate the areas with the greatest percentage of older people.
 - 132 Census Tracts
 - Overall % of total population 60 and above 13.3% (as of 2000)
 - Female: 56%, Male, 44%
- The other Light green to dark green map shows the total population of the senior population by Census Tract.
- When comparing the two maps, the darkest Census Tracts show the greatest number of seniors and the highest percentage of senior population.
Total population of 60 years and above by Census Tract (Based on 2000 Census data)
 - Total population 60 and above: 70,078
 - Female: 39,111; Male 30,967
 - Mean (average per census tract) 530
 - Median (mid point census tract - 66 tracts above, 66 tracts below)

THE BREAKDOWN OF SENIOR POPULATION BY AGE AND CENSUS TRACTS. THREE DIFFERENT GROUPS OF SENIORS ARE SHOWN: 60 TO 74 YEARS, 75 TO 84 YEARS, AND 85 AND OLDER (2000 CENSUS)

- Breakdown of population aged 60 - 74 by Census Tract (Based on 2000 Census data)
 - Total population 60 - 74 in Jefferson County (based on 2000 Census data); 47,604
 - Female: 25,037; Male: 22,567
 - Mean: 360
 - Median: 330
- Breakout of population age 75 - 84 by Census Tract (Based on 2000 Census data)

- Total population 75 - 84 years: 16,857
 - Female: 10,038; Male: 6,819
 - Mean: 130
 - Median: 93
- Breakout of population age 85 years and above by Census Tract (Based on 2000 Census data)
 - Total population 85+ years: 5,617
 - Female: 4,036; Male: 1,581
 - Mean: 43
 - Median: 21

A BREAKDOWN OF JEFFERSON COUNTY'S SENIOR POPULATION LIVING IN POVERTY BY CENSUS TRACTS INTO TWO GROUPS: 65 TO 74 YEARS AND 75 YEARS AND OLDER. THE DARKER THE RED COLOR, THE LARGER NUMBER OF SENIORS LIVING IN POVERTY.

- Population 65 - 74 below the Poverty Status in 1999 by Census Tract (77 of 133 Census Tracts in Jefferson County have a value of "0" and were excluded)
 - 56 Census Tracts
 - Total population 65 - 74 years below Poverty Status in 1999: 979
- Population age 75+ below the Poverty Status in 1999 by Census Tract (61 of 133 Census Tracts in Jefferson County have a value of "0" and were excluded)
 - 72 Census Tracts
 - Total population 75 and above below Poverty Status in 1999: 1,508
