It will be an unforgettable event, with stories from legendary pilots, fun-filled Adventure Zone™ activities that educate and excite children about aviation, hundreds of aircraft to see on the ground, including rare war birds, and of course a fantastic display of flight performances with *thrilling aerobatics, afterburners and pyrotechnics* the whole family will enjoy.
