## Proclamation



### Older Americans Month

## Business Meeting

### Approval of Head Start Grant Submittal

The BCC approved the Jefferson County Head Start's grant submittal for funding for 2009. Head Start will submit the grant proposal to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) and FY Appropriation Funds.

### Clear Creek Canyon Park Easement

The BCC approved the Easement Agreement with the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT). The easement was granted for future rockfall mitigation. The county has determined

that CDOT's proposed rockfall mitigation on Open Space will not impair development of trail and other recreational improvements in Clear Creek Canyon.

### Concrete Removal and Replacement

The BCC approved the contract between Jefferson County and Concrete Express, Inc. for concrete removal and replacement services. The contract amount is not to exceed \$1,215,000 and work shall be completed by December 2009.

### Asphalt for Airport Taxiway

The BCC approved the contract between Jefferson County and Asphalt Specialties Co. The contract is for construction services for the sixth and final phase of construction services for the relocation of the taxiway at Rocky Mountain Metropolitan Airport. The contract amount is \$1,829,865 and the work is scheduled to be complete by July 2009
