## Business Meeting

### Appointments to Jefferson County Boards

The BCC appointed Dar Vriesman as a regular member and Deborah Hughes as an alternate member to the Jefferson County Community Development Advisory Board. Donald Rosier II, Richard Scheurer and Kate Cooke were also reappointed as regular members. The appointments are set to expire September 20, 2012, or until reappointed or replaced by the BCC.

Sam Craig Wright was appointed to the Jefferson County Housing Authority Board, with a term to expire October 8, 2009, or until reappointed or replaced.

### Volunteer Fire Assistance Grants Important to Preventative Projects

The BCC approved matching funds for a grant between Jefferson County and the Colorado State Forest Service, which recognize the importance of preventative projects when addressing fire preven-

tion. The Volunteer Fire Assistance (VFA) funding supports equipment costs and requires a 50% cash match. The Department of Emergency Management will provide this match, with a \$10,321 award total.

### Neighbors Ask for Noise Barrier as Part of Landscape Installation

The BCC approved an amendment to a landscape contract as part of work for improvements to West Belleview Avenue from South Simms Street to West Quincy Avenue. This amendment would add \$45,581 for a new sound barrier fence.

After completion of widening along West Belleview Avenue, three residents requested an eight-foot fence to mitigate the noise in their backyards. Approximately 295 feet of fence will fill in a missing section that exists between a concrete block wall and a resident's stucco fence. This fence will be located

within the county right-of-way and will match the existing fences along West Belleview Avenue.

### Transition Planning for Youth with Disabilities

The BCC approved of the agreement between Jefferson County and the University of Colorado Denver for a pilot program. Colorado WIN Partners, a section within the Department of Pediatrics, School of Medicine of the University of Colorado Denver, has selected the Tri-County Workforce Region for the Person-Centered Independence Planning Project (PIPP), a pilot grant.

PIPP will provide transition planning for youth with developmental disabilities and will develop and implement a coordinated effort to provide transition-related training to parents, caregivers and partners.

The BCC holds public hearings to set policies and make decisions regarding land use, transportation, open space purchases, social service concerns, community development, law enforcement, libraries, public health and other vital issues concerning our county.
