CONSIDERATION FOR APPOINTMENT

JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

The Board of Adjustment (BOA) is a seven-member board, created by State Statute and appointed by the Board of County Commissioners. The BOA has the authority to grant variances and/or special exceptions to established zoning regulations, if an adequate hardship or practical difficulty has been demonstrated. The BOA grants Variances (e.g., reduction of required setbacks or lot size, or increase in height, etc.) that run with the land and Special Exceptions (e.g., temporary structures, home occupations, etc.) which are granted for a specified length of time, and require rehearing and renewal upon expiration.
