**Purpose:** To provide a means by which individuals or groups within Jefferson County can participate in removing litter from County Roads and Streets.

**Policy:** Adopt-A-Road/Street Litter Control Program

A. The Program

1. The Transportation and Engineering Division and the Development and Transportation Department shall implement a litter control program for interested groups pursuant to this policy and the procedures that implement this policy.
2. County Roads/Streets considered for inclusion under this program shall be limited to those classified as Collectors and Arterials located within the unincorporated portions of the County. This program will not include Neighborhood or Local Streets/Roads.
3. Participation in this program shall be limited to individuals or participating groups located within (or with local chapters or affiliates located within) Jefferson County.
4. The Transportation and Engineering Division shall approve only those requests from responsible organizations deemed reasonably able to comply.

B. Each adopting organization shall commit to the following:

1. Compliance with the procedure that implements this policy.
