



First Judicial District Attorney's Office Externship Program May 14 through August 10, 2012

The Program

The First Judicial District Attorney Office's externship program is a program designed to give first and second year law students practical experience in research and writing or in the courtroom.

We offer law students who have completed their first year an opportunity to work for the Chief Appellate District Attorney. The extern's responsibilities include research and writing on various felony and misdemeanor legal issues.

Under the Student Practice Act, we offer law students who

have completed four full semesters an opportunity to work in the court room with the County Court Deputy District Attorneys. The majority of cases are traffic related cases. Externs may also assist on other criminal matters. Typically, each extern is assigned to a county court deputy and assists in court on jury trials, motions and docket.

The majority of the positions are for credit or on a volunteer basis. Occasionally, we offer paid externships.
