RE: Jeffco DA assists with Dewild Missing Persons Investigation

The Edgewater Police Department is continuing its missing persons investigation into the disappearance of 30-year-old Heather Dewild. She was last seen in Edgewater on July 24. The Jefferson County District Attorney's Office is also providing its assistance and has asked the First Judicial District Grand Jury to look into the disappearance of Mrs. Dewild.

On Thursday, July 31, law enforcement obtained a second search warrant as part of their investigation. The search warrant has been sealed pending the outcome of this investigation.

Police continue to search for her car: a white, four-door 1996 Nissan Sentra with Colorado license, GBI 6568. Dewild is described as 4 ft. 9 inches tall and weighs 100 pounds with sandy blonde hair and blue eyes. Anyone with information is asked to call the Edgewater Police Department at 303-278-2000.

There is no further information available on this investigation at this time from either the District Attorney's Office or the Edgewater Police Department.
