**RE:** Antonio Aguilar Pleads Guilty to Second Degree Murder

---

Antonio Aguilar, DOB: 4-28-78, entered a guilty plea today to a charge of second degree murder in the death of Lakewood attorney Tom Roberts.

Aguilar faces from 22-59 years in prison for this count and for five counts that a Jefferson County jury found him guilty of on February 1, 2005. Those five counts are first degree burglary, second degree burglary, robbery, theft and conspiracy to commit robbery. At the end of the jury trial, the jury was unable to reach a unanimous verdict on the two first degree murder counts originally charged. Prosecutors had planned to retry those counts in April.

He will be sentenced on March 22, at 8:00 a.m., in Division 7 of the Jefferson County Courts.

Three others involved with this case are: Terri Ann Martinez, who pled guilty to second degree murder in April, 2004 and was sentenced to 20 years in prison, plus five years parole. Linda Rita Garcia-Aguilar, pled guilty to first degree burglary and one violent crime count in April 2004 and was sentenced to 22 years in prison, with five years parole. Terry Leslie was found guilty of 1<sup>st</sup> degree murder on February 18, 2005. He will be sentenced on March 18, 2005 at 9:00 a.m. in Division 7 of the Jefferson County District Court.
