**RE:** Mackenzie Kingry Murder Case Indictments

A grand jury in Jefferson County has returned indictments charging two alleged gang members with murder for the death last October of 17-year-old Mackenzie Kingry of Lakewood.

According to the indictment, Angelo Montoya and Dominic Duran were uninvited guests at a high-school party held at a Wheat Ridge home last October 24. When the host of the party asked Montoya to leave, Montoya pulled a handgun and, as he ran from the home to Duran's vehicle, sprayed the home with bullets. Duran fired additional shots at the home as the two men fled the scene in Duran's vehicle.

One of the bullets passed through a window of the home and fatally injured Ms. Kingry. According to the indictment, the grand jury was unable to determine which of the two men fired the fatal shot. The grand jury found, however, that both men were responsible for Ms. Kingry's death.

District Attorney Scott Storey remarked that the indictments reflect the strong commitment of his office and all Jefferson County law enforcement agencies to aggressively prosecute gang violence.
