RE: Terry Leslie Sentenced to Life in Prison with an Additional 13
Years

Terry Leslie, Jr., DOB: 11-01-76, of Denver was sentenced today to life in prison in connection with the death of Lakewood attorney Thomas Roberts in September, 2003.

In February, a Jefferson County jury deliberated just over a day before convicting Leslie of eight counts, including two first degree murder counts, first and second degree burglary, robbery, conspiracy to commit robbery, felony theft and misdemeanor theft. The murder convictions carried a mandatory sentence of life without possibility of parole; Leslie received an additional 13 years in jail for the other counts.

Leslie was tried by Jefferson County prosecutors Doug Cohen and Lee Harrell, who also prosecuted three other persons charged in Robertson's robbery and homicide.
