**RE:** Jeffco Jury Convicts Terry Leslie of First Degree Murder

A Jefferson County jury this afternoon returned guilty verdicts on all counts in the trial of Terry Leslie, Jr. DOB: 11-01-76, of Denver. The jury deliberated just over a day before convicting Leslie of eight counts, including two first degree murder counts, first and second degree burglary, robbery, conspiracy to commit robbery, felony theft and misdemeanor theft. Leslie was one of four people charged with the death of Lakewood attorney Thomas Roberts in September, 2003.

Earlier in February, a second man charged in the murder, Antonio Aguilar, DOB: 4-28-78, was also tried by Jeffco prosecutors Doug Cohen and Lee Harrell, but the jury hung on the two first degree murder counts. Those counts will be tried again on April 4, 2005. Aguilar is scheduled to be sentenced on the other five counts on March 4, 2005.

Terri Ann Martinez, DOB: 11-1-60, Terry Leslie's girlfriend, pled guilty to second degree murder in April, 2004 and was sentenced to 20 years in prison, plus five years parole, on June 25, 2004. Linda Rita Garcia-Aguilar, DOB: 4-13-75, Aguilar's girlfriend, pled guilty to first degree burglary and one violent crime count on April 26 and was sentenced to 22 years in prison, with five years parole, on June 25, 2004.

Terry Leslie will be sentenced on March 18, 2005 at 9:00 a.m. in Division 7 of the Jefferson County District Court.
