**Jefferson County 2012 Election Judge Application**

Please complete this application if you are interested in serving as an Election Judge for the **November 6, 2012 General Election**. Depending on your qualifications and number of judges needed by political party per polling place, you will be contacted in September/October if a position becomes available.

You must agree to attend the training class(es) required for your specific type of assigned Judge position. If assigned to serve as a Judge, you will be expected to work at your assigned polling place from 6:00am until approximately 8:00pm on Election Day.

**ELECTION JUDGE POSITIONS**

**LEAD JUDGES** are responsible for picking up the supplies the Saturday before the Election and returning them after the polling place has closed. The week before the Election, Lead Judges contact the polling place and the other Judges assigned. They also coordinate the activities of the Judge team and assist voters throughout the day.

**SUPPORT JUDGES** help set up the polling place, assist with the registration book and provide voters with their ballot. They are also responsible for helping with the final paperwork and closing duties after the polls close. A Support Judge may be asked to accompany the Lead Judge in returning the supplies on Election night.

**MACHINE JUDGES** are responsible for operating the paper ballot scanner and the touchscreen voting machine. Machine Judges assist voters and help the Lead Judge in opening and closing the polls and equipment. A Machine Judge may be asked to accompany the Lead Judge in returning the supplies on Election night.

**ALTERNATE JUDGES** are recruited to cover vacant positions arising from last minute Judge cancellations or high volume polling places. Alternate Judges report to the Jefferson County Elections Dept. at 6:00am and await a polling place assignment. Most, if not all, Alternate Judges will receive assignments based on the needs of the Election Dept. Alternate Judges that are not assigned will still be compensated for serving the entire day.
