Ballot drop-off locations for Jefferson County

(Golden) – Jefferson County voters who do not want to drop their 2008 General Election ballots off in the mail may choose to drop it off at any of eleven different locations throughout the county.

Voted ballots can be dropped off at:

County ballot drop-off locations are open Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. City Hall ballot drop-off locations are open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. All ballot drop-off locations are open on Election Day, November 4, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

“We understand that for some voters, it may be preferable or more convenient to drop their ballot off, rather than sending it through the mail, so we’ve partnered with our local city clerks to provide additional drop-off locations within the community that may be closer to home for voters,” said Pam Anderson, Jefferson County Clerk and Recorder.

For voters choosing to send the ballot back in the mail, two first-class postage stamps are required. Voters are encouraged to send ballots in as early as possible to aide election officials in verifying eligibility and counting ballots.

The deadline to drop-off voted ballots is 7 p.m. on Election Day. Ballots sent through the mail must be **received** by the Clerk and Recorder’s office by the deadline. A postmark does not count as receipt.
