(Golden) – The 2008 General Election is Tuesday, November 4, 2008. The polls will be open on Election Day from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Mail-in ballots can be obtained by submitting an application form to the Jefferson County Clerk and Recorder’s Office. Forms are available at the Clerk’s office, or at www.votejeffco.com.

If a voter would like your ballot mailed to them, the deadline to submit an application is Tuesday, October 28th.

If a voter would like to pick up a ballot in person at the Clerk and Recorder’s Office, the deadline to submit an application is Friday, October 31st.
