**2010 Primary mail ballot election information**

(Golden) – As previously announced in February of this year, the 2010 Primary Election will be conducted as an all mail ballot election in Jefferson County. Ballots will be mailed to all eligible Jeffco voters affiliated with either the Democratic, Republican or Libertarian parties beginning on July 19, 2010.

Voters who are not affiliated with a political party may choose to affiliate up to and on Election Day, August 10, in order to cast a party ballot for this election, but it is recommended that they don't wait for Election Day.

Jefferson County will have five Service Centers open throughout the county beginning Monday, July 19, where voters can get a replacement ballot, declare a party affiliation, and drop off voted mail ballots. Service Centers are open Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.; and also on Saturday, August 7 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., and Election Day, August 10, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Ballot drop-off locations are open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Saturday, August 7 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., and Election Day from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

“We’ve again partnered with our local city clerks to provide drop-off locations within the community that may be closer to home for voters,” said Pam Anderson, Jefferson County Clerk and Recorder. “We realize that some voters prefer to cast a ballot in person, rather than dropping it in the mail,” she added.

The deadline to drop-off voted ballots is 7 p.m. on Election Day. Ballots sent through the mail must be ***received*** by the Clerk and Recorder’s office by the deadline. A postmark does not count as receipt.
