Shall Section 5.10.1 of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Wheat Ridge, Colorado, be amended by the addition of a new Subsection g, exempting the following areas of the City from the limitations of that section upon Building Height and Residential Density: (1) that area described in the West 44th Avenue/Ward Road Redevelopment Plan, adopted October 22, 2001, and (2) that area described in the I-70/Kipling Corridors Urban Renewal Plan, adopted August 10, 2009, excluding therefrom all properties in the Plan Area along the Kipling Street Corridor South of 44th Avenue and all properties in the Plan Area East of Interstate 70, North of 32nd Avenue, West of Ward Road and South of the West 44th Avenue/Ward Road Redevelopment Plan Area, without modifying any current zoning on any property and preserving existing Height and Density limitations in the Wheat Ridge Code of Laws unless and until modified through future ordinances approved by City Council after public hearings?

Shall the City of Wheat Ridge grant to the Public Service Company of Colorado, an Xcel Energy Company, by a Franchise Agreement the right to provide utility service to the City and to its residents under tariffs on file with the PUC and to acquire, purchase, construct, install, locate, maintain, operate and extend into, within and through the City all company facilities reasonably necessary to generate, furnish, sell, transmit, transport and distribute utility service within the City and the right to make reasonable use of all streets and other public places and public easements as may be necessary to carry out the Franchise for a period of 20 years and pursuant to the terms of the Franchise Agreement?

TOWN OF BOW MAR

Ballot Issue 2F

SHALL THE TOWN OF BOW MAR DEBT BE INCREASED UP TO \$ 1,250,000 WITH A MAXIMUM REPAYMENT COST OF UP TO \$ 2,500,000, AND SHALL TOWN TAXES BE INCREASED UP TO \$ 180,000 ANNUALLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE REPAVING AND RESURFACING OF STREETS WITHIN THE TOWN, AND ANCILLARY COSTS AND IMPROVEMENTS RELATED TO THE REPAVING AND RESURFACING, SUCH DEBT TO CONSIST OF THE ISSUANCE AND PAYMENT OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS, WHICH BONDS SHALL BEAR INTEREST AT A MAXIMUM NET EFFECTIVE INTEREST RATE NOT TO EXCEED 6.5% PER ANNUM AND BE ISSUED, DATED AND SOLD AT SUCH TIME OR TIMES, AT SUCH PRICES (AT, ABOVE OR BELOW PAR) AND IN SUCH MANNER AND CONTAINING SUCH TERMS, NOT INCONSISTENT HEREWITH, AS THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY DETERMINE; AND SHALL AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES BE LEVIED IN ANY YEAR, WITHOUT LIMITATION AS TO RATE AND IN AMOUNTS SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF, PREMIUM IF ANY, AND INTEREST ON SUCH BONDS AS THE SAME BECOME DUE?

Ballot Question 2G

Shall the Town of Bow Mar, Colorado, be authorized to publish ordinances by title only rather than by publishing ordinances in full, thereby substantially reducing the costs incurred in the publication of ordinances in full?
