**INDIVIDUAL SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS CLEANER
LICENSE - Application and Instructions**

In accordance with Colorado state law, the Jefferson County Department of Health and Environment is now required to verify that persons applying for certain licenses are **LAWFULLY PRESENT in the United States. Use Department **FORM A** to document this requirement.**

USE THIS PACKET TO APPLY FOR A LICENSE FOR THE CLEANING OR PUMPING OF INDIVIDUAL SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS OR TRANSPORTING SEWAGE TO A DISPOSAL SITE. EMPLOYEES OF A PERSON WHO ALREADY HOLDS A SYSTEMS CLEANER LICENSE ARE NOT REQUIRED TO HOLD A SEPARATE LICENSE IN THEIR OWN NAME.

POSSESSION OF A SYSTEM CLEANER LICENSE DOES NOT PERMIT THE LICENSE-HOLDER TO PERFORM INSPECTIONS OF EXISTING INDIVIDUAL SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS FOR THE USE PERMIT PROGRAM. HOWEVER, A PERSON HOLDING A SYSTEMS CLEANER LICENSE MAY INSPECT TANKS AND OTHER TREATMENT UNITS FOR THAT PURPOSE.

INSTRUCTIONS

- There is no test required to obtain a systems cleaner license.
- The initial licensing fee is **\$30.00** per calendar year and **\$15.00** per calendar year thereafter. (payable to Jefferson County Treasurer)
- Complete and submit **FORM A** to document your lawful presence in the United States.
- Return the completed application form and the appropriate fee to the Department – allow approximately ten (10) days to process and approve your license.

PART VII OF THE JEFFERSON COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT'S INDIVIDUAL SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM REGULATIONS REQUIRES THAT A LICENSED SYSTEMS CLEANER:

- *Remove the liquid, sludge and scum from the tank, leaving no more than 3 inches depth of sewage in a septic tank or aeration plant, including all chambers of multi-compartment tanks.*
- *Maintain their equipment to prevent sewage spills and protect their employees from health hazards.*
- *Dispose of the collected sewage only at an acceptable site as determined by the department.*

I HEREBY AGREE TO CONDUCT ALL OPERATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THESE REGULATIONS.
