Social High Risk/ Parenting/ Expedited Permanency Planning - home visits for children who have been or are at risk for abuse and/or neglect.

Partners for Healthy Families - prenatal and early childhood nurse home visitation program for first time mothers who meet financial guidelines.

Prenatal Plus Program - case management program to assure healthy birth outcomes by addressing the lifestyle, behavioral and non-medical aspects likely to effect a woman's pregnancy and overall well being.

Prenatal, Postpartum, Newborn Home Visit Program - home visits for women who are pregnant or have recently given birth.

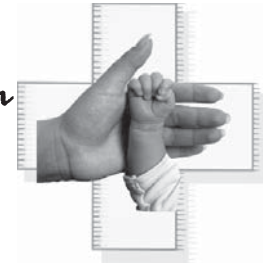

You may qualify for this **FREE** service if you:

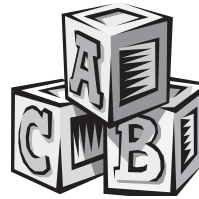
- Are on Medicaid or Presumptive Eligibility (PE)

If you are eligible, you and your family will receive:

Support from a nurse, dietician, and counselor

- Home or office visits by staff trained to work with your special needs
- Help getting your Medicaid card
- Answers to your questions about pregnancy, labor and delivery and caring for your baby
- Information on resources in your community to help you and your baby
- Staff can spend time with you during your pregnancy and after, until your baby is two months old

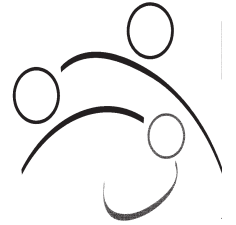

Are you expecting your first child?

The **Nurse Family Partnership** is a voluntary program to help you and your child begin a healthy life together.

You may qualify for this **FREE** service if you:

- Are expecting your first child?
- Have a limited income?



If you are eligible, you and your family will receive:

- Home visits by specially trained nurses during your pregnancy and up to your child's second birthday
- Extensive one-on-one support from your nurse
- Information to help with your pregnancy and delivery
- Parenting information to help your child grow and be healthy
- Information on resources in the community to help meet your family's needs
