

As of the end of 2005:

- ✦ Globally, over 40 million people are estimated to be living with HIV/AIDS. Of these, 38 million are adults, 17.5 million are women, and 2.3 million are children under the age of 15.
- ✦ Over 950,000 Americans and more than 19,000 Coloradans are living with HIV/AIDS.

## How is HIV transmitted?

 A person can become infected when one of the four body fluids carrying HIV enters his/her body. The four body fluids are:

- ◆ blood
- ◆ semen
- ◆ vaginal fluids
- ◆ breast milk

 Body fluids can enter the body through:

- ◆ A cut, tear, or break in the skin.
- ◆ A puncture with a needle or other tool.
- ◆ The tissues (mucus membranes) found inside the eyes, nose or mouth; inside the vagina; the lining of the anus; and at the tip of the penis.

 An HIV infected person can spread HIV to another person through:

- ◆ Vaginal, oral or anal sex.
- ◆ Sharing needles or other tools for drug use, tattooing or body piercing.
- ◆ Breastfeeding.



## How much does a test cost?



The charge for the counseling session and test is only \$30.00.

## What happens when I get a test?

When you call to make an appointment at JCPH:

- ✓ A certified test-site counselor will go over your risks with you, and answer your questions.
- ✓ The counselor will work with you to develop a plan to reduce and/or eliminate your risk factors.
- ✓ Rapid testing available!

Tests are only conducted one-on-one, and you can change your mind about testing at any time. **Results are only given in person.**

## Confidential Testing

- ◆ When you have a **confidential** test you provide your name, address and phone number to the test-site counselor, and this information is kept in your file. Any collected information is protected and utilized to help plan effective prevention efforts.
