- **Walk the perimeter of the site and the transition zones to 38th Ave.;** and
- **Record observations and generate ideas about walkability.**

Communities around the country are using walking audits to enhance safety and accessibility for pedestrians, cyclists and users of public transportation of all ages and abilities. By participating you will gather an expanded understanding of how a walking audit works and how individuals or groups can use it to document observations about the built environment in their communities.
