

Notice of Bridge Repairs – Plainview Road Over Coal Creek

Beginning September 7, 2010, ABCO Contracting will begin repairs to the bridge over Coal Creek on Plainview Road. Work is expected to take approximately 2 months.

The bridge is located approximately 0.5 miles north of SH 72, just beyond the Open Space parking lot. Plainview Road will remain open during construction.

Repairs will be made in two phases as crews work on one half of the bridge at a time. As a result, the bridge crossing will be open to one lane only. Drivers should obey the traffic controls by stopping at the bridge approaches and yielding to oncoming traffic.

Bridge repairs will include a new concrete deck, repaired girders, improved bridge railing with guardrail on all sides, and a new gravel surface on each end of the bridge. This bridge repair project is possible through the Funding Advancements for Surface Transportation and Economic Recovery, (“FASTER” funds).
