CDOT Updates

- Region 1- Peter Kyninski – Requested minutes of October meeting regarding Twin Tunnels Project be changed to reflect a completion date of 2013 not 2012. Discussed alternate route for Highway 285 surface treatment.
- Region 6 – Reza Akhavan – Project Updates: SH-93 (resurfacing 58th Ave.-SH-128) starting mid-August and completion 2012 – US 85 at C-470 Flyover 84% complete – US 6 at Wadsworth FIR, Feb. 2012, FOR, December 2012, Plans, specs and estimates will be in February 2013 - Wadsworth Roadway Capacity Project, FIR scheduled for November 29, 2011, FOR July 2012, AD, September 2012 – Resurfacing projects in Jefferson County slated for advertisement: Colfax Ave, Cole to Tabor March 2012, expediting to January 2012- Sheridan Blvd, 68th to US 36, January 2012 - Kipling St. 38th to I-70, April 24, 2012. The Wadsworth Blvd. Concrete White Topping project is ongoing and slated for completion December 2011 – Bridge Enterprise Projects: 58th over Ford, preliminary scoping, Wadsworth/Bear Creek, under advertisement, 6th Ave./Sheridan, under advertisement, bid opening on

Nov. 17th. – Sheridan over Union Pacific Railroad status, waiting on railroad's CM agreement to get signed. – Excavation for Union light rail tunnel is ongoing.

RTD Update- No update due to Robert Rynerson's presentation on the West Corridor Draft Service Plan.

DRCOG Update – Steve Rudy – Projects being evaluated for ITS Pool including following Jefferson County Projects – Lakewood, \$200,000 for system detection and provision of travel times on Wadsworth; CDOT, \$300,000 for provision of travel times on US 6 in Clear Creek Canyon; CDOT, \$800,000 for C-470 from Santa Fe to Bowles for provision of traveler information. This will complete ITS infrastructure on entire C-470 corridor. TIP program received extra money from FY-11 final appropriations, Metro Vision Issues Committee reviewing options for the additional \$27 million. Board meeting next week to determine use of funds, likely include \$10m to projects on the waiting list.

Around the Horn:

Dave Evans – Bike Jeffco - mentioned latest bicycle fatality on 100th Avenue and noted that there are more vehicles and bicyclist in the north area of the county

Lakewood – Dave Evans, Wrapping up bus paving – Quincy/Kipling wire melted, knocked out controls.

Jeffco – Commissioner Rosier, Jefferson Parkway - continue to go through mediation with cities and CDOT. On November 11, 2011 Jefferson County turned 150 years old.

Westminster – On street bike lanes were installed on 112th avenue between Sheridan Boulevard and Westminster Boulevard.

Arvada – Marc Williams is the new Mayor.

Policy Group Discussions

West Corridor Draft Service Plan - Robert Rynerson and team presented proposed changes and rationale for developing a bus service plan to coordinate with the opening of the West Corridor. Service plan based on meetings with community, employment and housing centers, proposed call-n-ride service, walking distances/pedestrian facilities, etc. East of Kipling focus is on coordination of regularly scheduled bus routes, west of Kipling focus on circulators and call-n-ride service. Service Plan also considers coordination with future Gold Line.

C-470 Coalition – Art Griffin (Douglas County) and Larry Warner (Parsons Brinckerhoff) presented overview of the C-470 Coalition and update the group on the efforts. Process has been spear-headed by Douglas County and is focused on improving mobility in the C-470 corridor. Presentation is attached for more information.
