

# Issuance of Temporary Permits

## **Starting January 1, 2012**

In order to come into compliance with CRS 29-2-106, CRS 39-26-106, and 39-26-208 (1&2) Jefferson County will no longer issue Temporary Permits to vehicles without payment of all applicable Sales Taxes or proof of payment.

Please be advised that if all applicable Sales Taxes are not collected and a Temporary Permit or permanent plates are not issued prior to 60 days from the vehicle purchase date, late fees will begin accumulating at the rate of \$25.00 per month, with a maximum of \$100.00.

*39-26-113(1) No registration shall be made of a motor or other vehicle for which registration is required and no certificate of title shall be issued for such vehicle or for a mobile home by the department of revenue or its authorized agent until any tax due on the sale and purchase of such vehicle pursuant to section 29-2-106, C.R.S., or section 39-26-106 or imposed by ordinance of any home rule city has been paid.*

*39-26-208(1) No registration shall be made of a motor or other vehicle for which registration is required and no certificate of title shall be issued for such vehicle or for a mobile home by the department of revenue or its authorized agent until any tax due upon the storage, use, or consumption thereof pursuant to section 39-26-202 or imposed by ordinance of any municipality or resolution of any county has been paid.*

*39-26-208(2) If an applicant for registration and certificate of title for any motor or other vehicle or for a certificate of title for a mobile home fails to show payment of the taxes applicable under this section by means of proper receipts therefore, the department of revenue or its authorized agent shall collect all such applicable taxes at the time such application is made.*
