

Lookout Mountain Nature Center Frequently Asked Questions

When is the Nature Center open?

Tuesday-Sunday 10:00 AM-4:00 PM
(Between Memorial Day and Labor Day, Saturday and Sunday hours are 9:00 AM-5:00 PM)

The Nature Center is closed on Mondays and all county holidays.

The Preserve and trails are open from 8:00 AM until dusk, 7 days a week.

What are the trails like on the Preserve?

The Forest Loop trail is 0.6 mile. The trail starts out going downhill on a gentle grade, and then goes uphill as you return towards the Nature Center. Benches are located along the Forest Loop trail.

The Meadow Loop trail is 0.8 mile. The Meadow Loop trail is less steep than the Forest Loop, although you must hike the Forest Loop to get to the Meadow Loop. The Meadow Loop trail affords good views of Denver.

The trails are suitable for strollers with sturdy wheels, but are not wheelchair accessible.

Where is the lookout?

Good views can be seen across the street from the parking lot entrance gate, from the Meadow Loop trail, or from Buffalo Bill's Grave and Museum.

Where can I hike with my dog?

Dogs are not allowed beyond the parking lot at the Nature Center. However, dogs are allowed on leash on the trails across the road from the Nature Center. Pick up a Windy Saddle Park Map for trail information.

Where is the nearest restroom?

After hours, the Nature Center has a restroom open just to the left of the main entrance doors.
