"Share the Trail" and "Bike Right" Events Scheduled in Jeffco Parks

Jefferson County Open Space Rangers and Volunteers are out in full force, spreading the good word on responsible park use and trail etiquette. To augment that effort, the public is invited to participate in "Bike Right" and "Share the Trail" events during the summer of 2010. The goal is to make each park visit a safe and enjoyable experience for all.

"Share the Trail" events are scheduled for each Tuesday afternoon/evening starting June 22 through August 3. "Share the Trail" Events begin at 5:00 p.m. at the following parks:

- June 22 - Apex Park
- June 29 - Deer Creek Canyon Park
- July 6 - Alderfer/Three Sisters Park
- July 13 - Meyer Ranch Park
- July 20 - Mount Falcon Park-West
- July 27 - Lair o' the Bear Park
- August 3 - Matthews/Winters Park

"Bike Right" events of particular interest for mountain bicyclists of all skill levels are scheduled for each Thursday afternoon/evening starting June 17 through July 29, 2010. "Bike Right" events begin at 5:00 p.m.

- June 24 - Lair o' the Bear Park
- July 1 - Matthews/Winters Park
- July 8 - Mount Falcon Park-East
- July 15 - Elk Meadow Park
- July 22 - Centennial Cone Park (Mayhem Gulch Trailhead)
- July 29 - Apex Park
