Dear Neighbors,

Progress is being made on improvements at North Table Mountain Park. As part of our efforts to enhance the recreation experience at the Park and preserve natural resources, Jefferson County Open Space is undertaking a series of trail projects in the Park this year. One project is right in your neighborhood.

With support from the Golden Parks and Recreation Department, Open Space will construct a 650-foot section of trail to connect the City of Golden parking lot on Wyoming Circle to our trailhead. A project map is provided on the back. This crushed-rock trail will reduce erosion, be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act and provide a sense of entry into the Park. Concurrently, a well-worn path leading from the parking lot up the mesa side contributes to soil erosion and will be closed and reclaimed.

We'll be starting these projects soon, with much of the work to be done on May 7 at Spring Into Service, a volunteer event co-sponsored by the Colorado Mountain Club and REI. We invite you to join us at the event! (See attached flyer for details.)

During the construction process, you may notice equipment and supplies staged in the city parking lot. Construction will be limited to the hours of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. In advance, we ask for your patience and understanding.
