



# Park Projects Update

*Here's an update on projects scheduled to take place in various parks over the next few months. Regular maintenance of trails and facilities occurs at all Jefferson County Open Space managed parks. These activities may occur as one-day or short term projects and may not be included in this highlighted list.*

*Spring 2008*

**CENTENNIAL CONE PARK** Seasonal closures in effect on Elk Range Trail for wildlife management. Restroom construction at the north and west trailheads is scheduled for mid 2008.

**MATTHEWS/WINTERS PARK** Currently under construction, trailhead improvements will no longer allow entry road parking, reduce bottleneck access and disperse use, create a separated biking entry to the park, provide a larger horse trailer and bus turnaround and reduce impacts to the riparian area. Anticipated completion by early June.

**MOUNT FALCON PARK** Forest management work at Mount Falcon Park - may encounter workers and equipment near main parking lot and along Castle Trail.

**ALDERFER/THREE SISTERS PARK** Forest management work at Alderfer/Three Sisters Park - may notice flagged and or painted trees on the Evergreen Mountain side of the park.

**WHITE RANCH PARK** Pile burning at White Ranch - may notice smoking piles of slash.

**SOUTH VALLEY PARK** Wildlife closures in effect. Stay on signed trails, do not climb on rock
