## **Notes:**

Q: For special study areas like Old Golden Road you should try to do that jointly with Golden.

A: Yes we will look into this.

C: You should have an “All of the above” answer option (referring to powerpoint slide before “Future of Transportation” slide).

Q: Will a copy of these survey results be posted on website?

A: Yes, results will be posted

Q: What is the difference between County and Open Space Trail plan?

A: Open Space deals with recreational trails, the County plan refers to Hard Surface trails. Open Space trails can be used for transportation, some are dual use, and we do take the Open Space Trail plan into account.

Q: For Multi-jurisdictional trails, Golden, Lakewood, Wheat Ridge – does current planning or future planning require common signage or trail type?

A: Currently, plans do not have any regulatory power over bike signage and each city or jurisdiction puts up their own signs. However, if this plan is allowed to move forward with policy recommendations then perhaps we could create an inter-jurisdictional sign policy.

C: Why not include the concept of a “Walking School Bus”, this idea is being done in Commerce City and towns across America. This helps out with traffic, childhood obesity, etc..., and saves money.

C: "Safe Routes to School" – plans safe routes to walk and bike, as well as educational materials, webinars/seminars to train public. Jefferson County could coordinate this.

A: Yes, we have applied and won grants like this, one example is the countdown timers that were installed.

C: Bike Colorado – statewide non-profits brought program and taught 24,000 students, state granted full use of funds for Jeffco Schools.

C: The impact on traffic for commuting kids is very large

C: 20-30% of traffic and be due to students

C: We should be coordinating with other jurisdictions

A: Yes, we have been coordinating with all surrounding counties.
