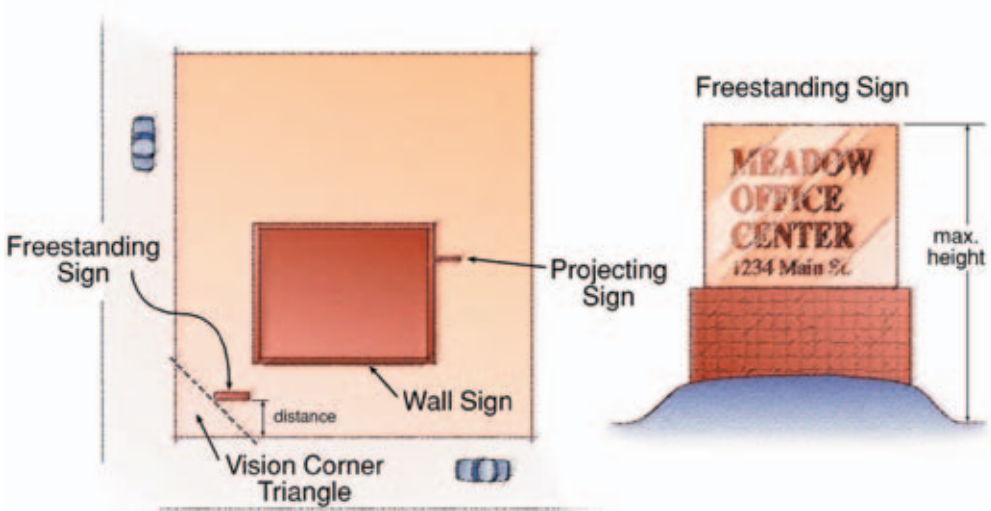


# How Do I

## Place a sign on a property?



### Things to know when applying for a sign permit

- No sign over 42" in height shall be placed in a vision corner triangle (V.C.T.).
- A scaled site plan will be required for freestanding signs, to ensure setbacks and other criteria are met.
- A scaled elevation of signs will be required, to verify placement on building or wall, showing square footage and height.
- When signs are placed on a berm, the berm height is included in height measurement.
- A process fee will be required.
- Freestanding signs cannot be placed in easements\*, waterways or floodplains.
- Offsite signs are not permitted for businesses.

\* Unless expressly permitted by Jefferson County regulation or by holder of the easement.
