	<p><i>Duplicated in the CMP</i> - The policy is already addressed in the Comprehensive Master Plan</p>	<p>If staff felt the Community Plan policy was already addressed in the Comprehensive Master Plan, this column lists what policies in the Comprehensive Master Plan staff felt were similar. Sometimes the middle column also gives additional explanation if the policy isn’t exactly the same language. Duplicative policies are not always in the same chapter as the original policy.</p>
	<p><i>Modify CMP</i> - A similar policy exists in the Comprehensive Master plan, but it needs to be modified to fully address the policy in the South Jefferson County Community Plan.</p>	<p>If staff felt an existing policy in the Comprehensive Master Plan needed to be modified to address the policy in the South Jefferson County Community Plan, this column shows exactly what policy would be changed and how.</p>
	<p><i>Add to CMP</i> - The Policy is a general policy that should be added to the Comprehensive Master Plan</p>	<p>If staff felt the policy was not addressed in the Comprehensive Master Plan, but was a general policy that would be applicable to the entire County, this column shows the proposed new language, and where exactly it would be added to the Comprehensive Master Plan. Please note that this language is not always exactly the same as the language in the South Jefferson County Plan policies. Staff may have modified it, with the idea of capture the intent of the South Jefferson County Plan policy. In some cases, staff combined similar policies from the North Plains and Central Plains Community Plans to create a new policy.</p>
	<p><i>Keep</i> – The policy is specific to the South Jefferson County Community Plan and will be kept in the area plan.</p>	<p>If staff felt the policy should be kept in the South Jefferson County Community Plan, this column lists why.</p>
	<p><i>Delete</i> – The policy should not be in either the Comprehensive Master Plan or the South Jefferson County Community Plan.</p>	<p>If staff felt the policy should be deleted and not addressed in either the Comprehensive Master Plan or the South Jefferson County Community Plan, this column lists why.</p>
