Studies have shown that no single object calms a troubled child as quickly as a teddy bear. The Jefferson County Sheriff's Office established the Deputy Hugs program in 1991, to provide comforting teddy bears to young victims of crime or crisis.

Who is Deputy Hugs?

Deputy Hugs is the name of the golden bear that deputies keep on hand, in their patrol cars. Whenever they come upon a child who is frightened or hurt, they can give a Deputy Hugs bear to the child to keep. The bear's T-shirt reads, "I got HUGS from the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office!" The bears provide comfort as well as a positive association with law enforcement officers. And, they can often make a deputy's job easier.

How Can You Help?

The Deputy Hugs program is funded in part by donations from the public. For a donation of \$20, you can adopt a Deputy Hugs bear for yourself or your child. At the same time, your donation will allow us to give a Deputy Hugs to a child in need.

Who Are Victim Advocates?

The Deputy Hugs program is administered through the Victim Services Unit. Victim advocates respond to the needs of victims of crime and crises by providing crisis intervention, support, referrals and assistance with the criminal justice process. The work of the Victim Services unit is based on the Colorado Victim's Bill of Rights.
