Deputy Troy Cope's son Andrew has had it rough since the day he was born. Andrew has nephrotic syndrome, a condition that has led to kidney failure. Andrew sometimes needs as many as 14 prescriptions, which can cost up to \$500 a month. In addition, he is no stranger to surgeries and procedures — Andrew is a frequent flyer at The Children's Hospital.

As Andrew's condition has worsened and medical bills have grown, Jefferson County Sheriff's Office employees have come to his parents' aid through the Employee Assistance Fund (EAF).

Many others have benefited from the EAF, including Sergeant Steve Wygant. Steve's wife, Jamie, has a blood clotting condition and was diagnosed with breast cancer in 2006. The Wygants visited a South Carolina specialist for more surgery following Jamie's double-mastectomy and oophorectomy. The costs of travel, lodging and medical services were mitigated by a contribution from the Employee Assistance Fund.

The EAF was established to help members of the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office "family" who are in financial need due to illness or death within their families. The EAF also assists the loved ones of officers killed in the line of duty. All proceeds from the Sheriff's Cup Golf Tournament go to the Employee Assistance Fund.
