

DRAFT FACILITY SCOPE Public Shooting Range Jefferson County

Minimum Requirements for Facility should include:

Outdoor Pistol	
Number of Lanes (Individual Stations)	10-15
Minimum Acreage	0.4 - 0.5 acres
Dimensions	50 yards long x 20 yards wide (plus room for "berming")
Outdoor Rifle	
Number of Lanes (Individual Stations)	10-15
Minimum Acreage	1.5 – 2.5 acres
Dimensions	200 yards long x 40 yards wide (plus room for "berming")
Parking, Restroom, Storage, etc.	
Additional Acreage	2-3 acres

General Assumptions:

- Range of acreage to accommodate "wish list" 5 acres up to 10 acres (if including trap/skeet)
- Pistol: Bulls-eye/target shooting
- Family Shooting area offering of BB and pellet (possibly .22 caliber)
- Rifle: "Sighting in"; hunting practice; bulls-eye.
- Parking, Restroom, Storage, etc.: Parking requirement roughly 1.5 spaces per lane; needs to be laid out once feasible sites identified.
- Trap & Skeet: Shotguns need fall area
- Archery: Bear Creek Lake Park (City of Lakewood) has outdoor archery range and unclear on demand for additional facility.
- Sporting Clays: Not a priority; more area and complex layout required (walking path through brush/cover); cost/benefit as well as user demand for this not clear.
