


Median Age

Colorado has really never had a large share of people over 65 when compared to other states. In 2010 Colorado ranked the 4th lowest in the 65+ age group. However, Colorado ranked 6th highest in Baby Boomers at 31% of the total population.

As of 2010, Jefferson County was ranked first in the State for having the most residents 65 years and over (67,411), followed by Denver County (62,132), El Paso County (62,051), and Arapahoe County (57,580).

The Median Age for Jefferson County in 2010 was estimated at 41.3 years, 38.7 for males and 41.6 for females. Colorado's Median Age was at 36.0 years with males at 35.1 and females at 37.1 years. The Median Age for the U.S. population was 37.2 years with males at 35.8 and females at 38.5 years.
