Medicaid for Pregnant Women

To apply for Medicaid for pregnant women you will need the following:

- Proof of pregnancy and due date with the signature of a medical provider.
- Proof of income from previous month
 This can be a pay stub or letter from your
 employer which includes the date, your
 previous month's income, phone number
 and name of the company.
- Social Security number for you and any children you are applying for.
- Birthdates of all the people living in your home that you are applying for.
- Proof of identification
 This can be a Valid US Passport, Resident Alien Card or a US Birth Certificate and a State-issued Driver's License or ID.
- Insurance Card (if you currently have health insurance)
- Have information available for:
 Child care, co-pays, health insurance payments, prescriptions, or medical items.

Once you have your documentation together, contact us at 303-232-6301 and we can help you apply for Medicaid for your pregnancy.

Presumptive Eligibility

JCPH can also help you get Presumptive Eligibility. This means that you may be able to get the care you need while waiting to be approved for Medicaid.

<u>CHP + for Pregnant Women</u>

If you are pregnant and have been declined for Medicaid, you may be eligible for Child Health Plan Plus (CHP+). JCPH can help you apply for this program which provides health care resources for children through the age of 18 years.

JCPH does not charge a fee, however once approved, the provider may charge a small fee and/or co-pay based on income and family size.
