

**Effective 5/28/2015 (C.R.S. 15-1327)**

The requirements are now:

- One party must be a resident of the State of Colorado
- One party has to appear in person to apply for the license and pay the required fee
- The party that is present shall sign the application and provide a signed and notarized absentee affidavit for the absent party
- The absent party must be a member of the armed forces of the US who is stationed in another country or in another state in support of combat or another military operation, or
- A government contractor, or an employee of a government contractor, working in support of the armed forces of the US or in support of US military operations in another country or another state
- Both parties are 18 years of age or older
